Under the direct supervision of the Associate Director of Day Program Services, the Direct Support Professional (DSP) assists with and supports the daily functions of individuals with developmental disabilities. As the DSP, use the person-center approach to for planning and developing centered plans to support the individuals we support. This is a Fulltime position is located at the Upper Marlboro, Md from Monday - Friday from 8:15am-3:15pm. The responsible of the DSP is to support people in all aspects of their lives including grocery shopping, meal prep, recreational and leisure activities, vocational activities, monitoring medical records and administer medication as needed and provides transportation to the people we support. Our goal is to assist the people we support to be involved in their community, encourage positive interactions, and to improve social connections and relationships. Activities should engage the individuals according to their individualized service plans.

Education and Experience:

- High School Diploma or equivalency preferred.
- Minimum of (3) years driving experience, with no more than (2) points on driving record.
- Experience working with developmentally disabled population, desirable.
