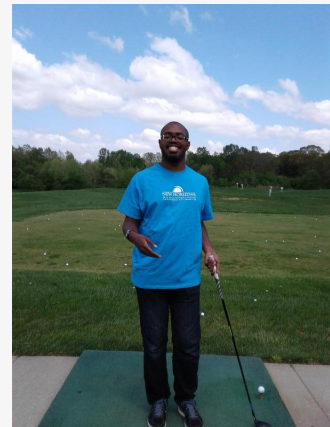


8th Annual "A Fairway to Help" A Huge Success!

By Funding us, you are helping to provide necessary skill development, job training, and employment services to help those we serve lead fulfilling and productive lives.

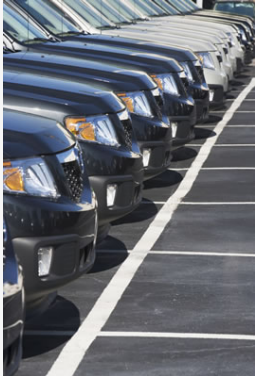
