Over \$89,000 Received in Grants in July



During the month of July, New Horizons was awarded over \$89,000 in grants to help support a variety of programs, including Supported Employment, Personal Supports, and Peer-to-peer Mentoring. The grants were the result of four applications submitted between January and May of this year, which were done in collaboration with Sidnae Global Research, a grant writing firm located in Prince George's County. We continue to work on applying for grants, with seven more being submitted during July and August.
