A special thank you goes out to all staff who volunteered to help out with the clinics.

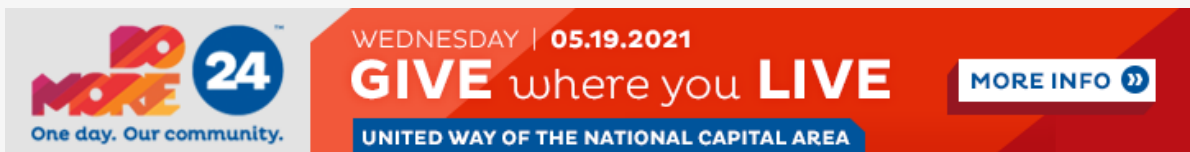
Second-Dose Vaccinations

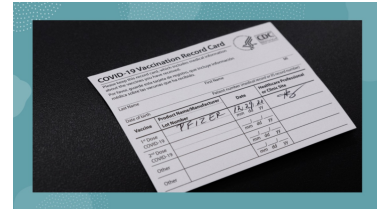
CVS Now Offering Over the Counter COVID Tests

In an effort to expand access to home testing, CVS Health Corp will now offer three over-the-counter COVID-19 tests in drugstores and online. The tests have received FDA Emergency Use Authorization and do not require a prescription and are intended for use by individuals with or without symptoms.



Prince George's County Now Providing Vaccination Cards

When the County Health Department initially opened its vaccination clinics, the department did not provide CDC vaccination cards, instead providing residents with electronic records after their vaccination. They have since changed that policy and are now providing vaccination cards at Health Department sites as residents get vaccinated.



If you did not receive a CDC vaccination card and would like one, please email the Health Department at COVID19_VaxCard@co.pg.md.us providing your name, address, date of birth, contact information, and the date and location of your vaccination. It may take several days to process the request, but once your vaccination card is ready, Health Department staff will follow up via email.
